

## **Notes from the Turtle Hall Harbour Marina Board May 22, 2023**

**-Dredging** has finally begun. They will take several loads prior to this holiday weekend and finish up after the holiday.

**-FISHERMAN!!!!** Someone is discarding large carcasses and fish heads into the marina basin. This creates a foul odor and we have had several complaints. Please be courteous and bag your fish waste and take it home. Also those with live bait storage containers at your dock also need to empty them frequently as the dead bait contribute to the smell problem.

**-DAY DOCK** We are continuing to have random boats tied up to our day dock. **NO BOATS SHOULD BE TIED TO THIS DOCK OVERNIGHT. NO GUEST BOATS SHOULD BE TIED TO THIS DOCK WITHOUT EXPRESS PERMISSION FROM THE BOARD.** We plan on towing these unidentified boats going forward. The cost of such a tow would approach several hundred dollars if you want to get your boat back! Please spread the word to all Turtle Hall residents both upper and lower.

**-Maintenance.** Please let us know if there are any issues with your pier so we can add it to the list. The water should now be working but we will need to change the holding tank that goes with the well system.

**-NO WAKE** A REMINDER THAT THE ENTIRE MARINA IS A NO WAKE ZONE!!! This includes the channel to the waterway. Please limit damage to our expensive bulkheads and boats. The wakes take a toll on the piers adjacent to the channel. Tell your family, friends and guests please.
